

Dear Abington Township Businesses:

I am pleased to report that the Town Revitalization Partnership Grant Program is available to all Abington Businesses located within a formalized business district. These include the areas of Keswick Village, Roslyn, Crestmont, North Hills, Ardsley, The Fairway, Old York Road to the southern boundary with Jenkintown Borough, Elkins Park and McKinley.

Essentially, our Economic Development Office is offering a fifty percent match of funding on projects costing up to \$4,000 in improvement cost. An information flyer describing the grant and an application are attached for your convenience. The application period will begin as of June 1, 2011 and will close on August 31, 2011. Our Economic Development Committee will review all applications at their September 2011 meeting, and award notice will be issued thereafter as the funds must be spent by December 16, 2011.

Applications will be awarded on the basis of greatest impact and visible change to a property, up to our grant fund limit. This is a great opportunity to improve your image and that of the business district of which you are a part.

Please note: If selected partnership grant award recipients do not exceed the current grant funding, previous award recipients will be considered to utilize the remainder of grant funds. Therefore, we encourage all business to apply.
